How to Move Around

The vaporetto is the main mode of public transportation on the waterways of Venice. Operating on the Grand Canal and other major canals, vaporettos provide a practical means of getting around the city. With various lines connecting key landmarks, they offer a unique and scenic perspective of Venice's architectural wonders. For a more private and personalized experience, water taxis are available for hire. These sleek motorboats can be a convenient option for individuals or groups, offering direct routes to specific destinations and a faster mode of transport compared to the vaporetto. While often associated with romantic rides, gondolas are also a form of transport in Venice, albeit more commonly used for short trips or special occasions. They offer a leisurely and intimate way to explore the smaller canals, providing a glimpse into the city's quieter and less-traveled waterways. These are gondola ferries that cross the Grand Canal at strategic points. Though not as common as other forms of transport, traghetto offer a unique experience, allowing passengers to hop on for a short journey across the canal, typically at a lower cost than a full gondola ride.
